Rick Miller has 30 years of travel and relocation experience in the Government Service. He retired from the Air Force in 2002 in which he held several travel, relocation, and budget positions at various military base, command, and headquarters locations.

Upon his retirement from military service, he immediately joined the Air Staff in the Pentagon as the Civilian Travel and Relocation Program Manager providing policy guidance to Air Force finance and personnel offices. While at the Air Staff, he managed over a \$60M annual budget to relocate 1500 civilian career employees and assisted with over 300 real estate sales under the Guarantee Home sales program annually. He also served on several review boards to improve management and development of travel and relocation policies throughout the Government.

In April 2008, he joined General Services Administration (GSA), Travel, Transportation and Asset Management staff. In his current position, as a Travel and Relocation Policy Program Manager, he provides travel and relocation policy to all federal agencies travel and relocation managers and updates the Federal Travel Regulation based on changes to statutory law. He has a degree in Financial Management and was a member of the first group to receive the Certified Government Travel Executive (CGTE) designation from the Global Business Travel Association (GBTA).
